Artery: a blood vessel in the circulatory		
system that carries blood away from the		
heart. Works in conjunction with		
respiratory system.		
Capillary: very thin blood vessels that		
branch off of arteries.		
Chemical Breakdown: enzymes produced		
by the body that break down food particles		
into smaller molecules.		
Circulatory System: channels through		
which nutrient fluids of the body flow; often		
restricted to the vessels conveying blood.		
Diffusion: transfer of material through a		
medium in the body systems.		
Digestive System: process in which food is		
converted into substances that can be		
absorbed and used by the body.		
Enzyme: a complex chemical produced by		
living cells for breakdown of substances.		
Used greatly in excretory and digestion.		
Excretory System: system that removes		
excess, unnecessary or dangerous		
materials, so as to help maintain balance		
and prevent damage to the body. It is		
responsible for the elimination of the waste		
products.		
Involuntary: automatically happens and		
does not have to be controlled by the mind.

Mechanical Breakdown: movements of the

Plasma: yellowish fluid in blood and is part of the circulatory system.	
Respiratory System: respiratory tract; the tubular and cavernous organs that allow atmospheric air to reach the membranes across which gases are exchanged with the blood.	
Skeletal System: provides the shape and form for our bodies in addition to supporting, protecting, allowing bodily movement, producing blood for the body, and storing minerals.
